2) American Medical Student Association / AMSA Requests

For your information, we are sharing 3 resolutions developed by the student/trainee members of the AMA regarding GME training. The APPD is not asking you to take any action, this is provided only for your consideration. If you would like to discuss these requests as members of APPD, please contact info@appd.org.

- Resolution 302 - Providing Residency Applicants a Timely Response to Residency Application Outcome
Specifically, students wish two things: confirmation that programs have received their applications and if they will **not** be granted an interview.
- Resolution 303 – Protecting Residents Against Avoidable Financial Constraint Related to Reimbursed Work-Related Expenses
Reporting delays of several months, residents propose reimbursements for training related expenses be more timely.
- Resolution 305 - Transparency on Maternity or Paternity Leave Policies for Trainees
Because they fear that asking about leave policies will result in a negative impression of them, they hope programs will post their policies, so they do not have to ask what the rules are.
