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4) ACGME new proposed Pediatric RRC Requirements

We are awaiting the release of the proposed Pediatric RRC Requirements. These should be posted to www.acgme.org by mid-July, with the expectation that new requirements would be implemented in July 2013. After the ACGME posts the final draft, there will be a period for commentary. The APPD is making plans to continue to seek member input and provide an avenue for discussion and networking through member conference calls. These calls will begin approximately 1-2 weeks after the requirements are released and you will receive emails regarding scheduling.
