2) APPD LEARN Update

Several APPD LEARN research studies have reached exciting milestones in the past few months. The network's first study, the APPD LEARN - NBME Pediatrics Milestones Assessment Pilot (PMAP) is currently finalizing several manuscripts that will highlight the myriad of results and lessons learned from the pilot. In addition to these manuscripts, the member-initiated study, "New Professionalism Challenges in Training: An Exploration of Social Media Use Among Pediatric Residents" completed data collection and submitted a manuscript describing the results of the study at the beginning of June.

The ongoing "Validity of Resident Self-Assessment Using the Pediatric Milestones" study is currently in its second phase of data collection. One of the most exciting things about this study is the number of institutions that have participated nationwide. 47 programs have enrolled in this study and began collecting data in Fall 2013!

Moving forward, APPD LEARN has several new developments on the rise. Recently, a new member-initiated study was approved by the Proposal Review Committee. This study will explore perceptions of service and education among pediatric trainees and directors. APPD LEARN has selected content experts for the first phase of the Pediatric Milestones Assessment Collaborative (PMAC). More information will be shared about opportunities to participate in this collaboration among APPD, ABP, and NBME in the coming months. Finally, The Council of Pediatric Subspecialties will be partnering with APPD LEARN to begin a study of competency-based assessment in fellowship programs.
