6) APPD Global Health PEG Scholarships Awarded

The APPD Global Health PEG was delighted to welcome the first two recipients of the APPD Global Pediatric Educator Scholarship at the APPD 2017 Annual Spring Meeting. Our goal is to recognize pediatric educators who demonstrate early leadership in improving pediatric education in low and middle income countries, and to provide them with additional career development and/ or networking opportunities by inviting them to attend the APPD spring conference.

We were delighted in our inaugural year to choose two exceptional individuals from a strong field of nominees. Dr. Mimi Mynak is one of only seven pediatricians in Bhutan and started a pediatric residency program there in 2014. Dr. Endale Tefera is a pediatric cardiologist in Ethiopia, but travelled to Liberia to help during the Ebola epidemic and then remained there on sabbatical to help with the development of Liberia's first pediatric residency program. Both awardees offered us outstanding insights into challenges and resources for expanding pediatric

training in low and middle income countries.

We hope to continue to offer this award annually, so that by sharing educational resources and fostering collaboration with these colleagues, we may further the goal of ensuring the health and well being of all children everywhere.
