Resident Research Grants
Call for Proposals 2015
Applications Due 7.24.2015**

Eligible Projects:

Projects initiated, designed, and executed by resident physicians enrolled in Mid-Atlantic Region APPD pediatric residency programs.

Research Focus:

*Proposals that seek advancement in knowledge pertaining to **resident education** in the realms of practice based learning and systems-based practice will have a priority. Proposals in other areas including **clinical, QI/safety, advocacy, translational research and/or that are projected to have an important impact on a resident's future career** will also be strongly considered.*

Funding: Up to \$1000

Requirements:

1. Research proposal
 - a. See attached format
 - b. Accompanied by written statement from program director that resident investigator can attend APPD regional meeting on **9.8.2015** if selected for grant
2. Project should be completed by primary author's graduation
3. Grant recipients will introduce projects at the Fall 2015 regional meeting
4. Grant recipients will present study results at either a national APPD meeting or the Fall regional meeting prior to/following graduation

Review Criteria:

Overall Quality, Significance, Innovation, Strategy/Methodology/Analysis, Impact

Selection Timeline:

July 24: Grant applications due

August 10: Grant recipients notified

September 8: APPD Mid-Atlantic Regional Fall meeting

ABMS Visiting Scholar Program

Now in its second year, the ABMS Visiting Scholar program is seeking applicants for the 2015-2016 academic year. This is a one-year program that is intended to provide early career physicians and scientists exposure to the fields of professional assessment and education, quality improvement and regulatory policy. Visiting Scholars will be provided \$12,500 to support a project that is completed locally. This is paired with 3 in-person meetings at the ABMS in Chicago where Visiting Scholars learn about the national landscape of assessment, education, QI, and policy.
