In this interactive workshop, we will engage participants in experiential learning about the impacts of diversity and social justice. We will discuss identity and the dynamics of power and privilege and we will demonstrate how to use an "inclusion lens" to develop and revise practices, policies and services within your program. Importantly, we will discuss concrete ways to engage trainees in lessons about social justice. Ultimately, we cannot simply teach about social justice and diversity and inclusion; we must advance an organizational culture – within our training programs, our departments and our national organizations - founded on justice and inclusion.

#### **Skill Building: Leadership (Friday)**
