This proposal describes the use of an intern check-in tool for early identification of struggling interns and as a method of facilitating feedback between residents and interns. They hope to validate their tool against standard measures of intern performance and examine its effect on the quality of mid-rotation feedback based on the perceptions of residents and interns.
