4) CME and Meeting Presentations from APPD/COMSEP Combined Meeting

To get your CME certificate, go to www.CmeCertificateOnline.com. **The online certificate site will be available through Friday, June 13th**. After that date, the site will be removed and certificates will no longer be available. If you need a CME / CE certificate, you must complete the evaluation and certificate process prior to that date; otherwise you will forfeit your credit for the conference.

Scroll down to the Association of Pediatric Program Directors listing and click on the APPD/COMSEP 2009 Combined Meeting event. On the site, you will be asked to enter a password which is **09APPD** and evaluate various aspects of the program. You may then print your certificate **immediately** (encouraged), anywhere you have internet access. No more waiting for the mail! A copy of the certificate will also be emailed to you in case you need to print additional copies (check your spam filter and junk email folder if you do not see it come through). The emailed copy is simply a backup if you didn't print it right away.

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If you were a presenter/speaker and your presentation has not been posted, please send the final version to the APPD office as soon as possible so that all attendees may benefit. We will also be contacting everyone in the near future about posting presentations on the APPD Share Warehouse.
